Across the Hyatt portfolio, we work to ensure all properties are aligned with our zero-tolerance approach to human trafficking and modern slavery which reflects our deep commitment to human rights and the dignity of people everywhere. This includes Dream properties as Hyatt acquired Dream Hotel Group on February 2, 2023."

Hyatt respects the fundamental human rights of all people, as embodied in the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights. We manage our business in line with this belief and strive to foster similar ideas in those with whom we do business. These principles align with Hyatt's purpose to care for people so they can be their best.

We have a zero-tolerance approach to human trafficking and modern slavery and have taken an aggressive approach to prevent human trafficking both at Hyatt properties and more broadly in the hospitality industry; more information can be found on our approach <u>HERE</u>.
