This includes the way we manage our relationships with distributors and other business partners and how we expect them to behave. Nestlé requires its suppliers, service providers, distributors and third parties acting on its behalf to act with integrity and to comply with anti-bribery laws. We reserve the right to change or end commercial relationships where these do not meet our requirements.
